This syndrome is primarily prevalent in War Veterans, Police,  
Ambulance and Triage Personnel, Fire Fighters and Emergency Service Personnel.

All of these people have contracted this condition in the service  
of their country or service to their fellow man.

**PTSD** is a relatively unknown mental disorder but credible sources say that at any one time,  
more than **1.5 Million Australians suffer** from it which in turn affects family and close associates.  
If we allocate just seven people to each sufferer then we can assume that nearly half the population  
of Australia is affected and most of them don't know the reason. **They need to be told.**



On November 25, 2012, many interested parties will join together in this event which will launch a national awareness campaign to show the Australian public, the symptoms of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and point sufferers, their families and their friends towards avenues of help.

This event will attract the majority of the national media, major politicians and at least 10,000 spectators to witness a day of cricket, soldiers and music. While it will be a day of fun and entertainment, the major messages of PTSD awareness will be broadcast in a subtle manner.

Cricket Australia and the Mental Health Council of Australia have demonstrated their support for this day as have Defence, The Southern Cross Austereo Radio Network, the major support groups and the Police Force, SES, Firefighters and Ambulance Service.

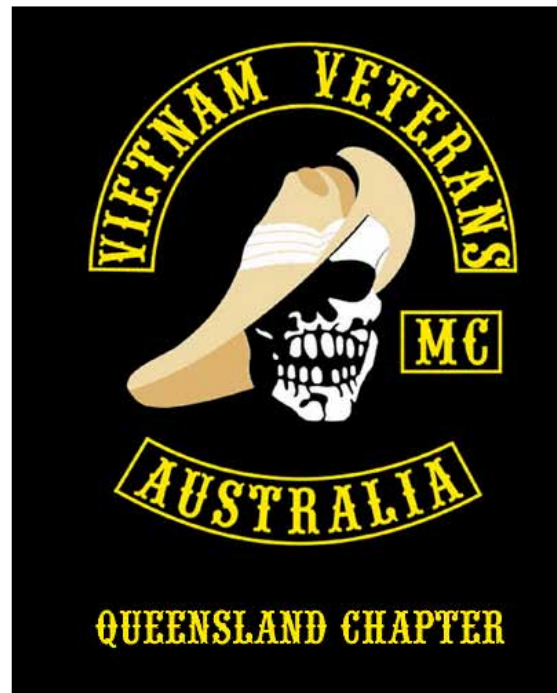

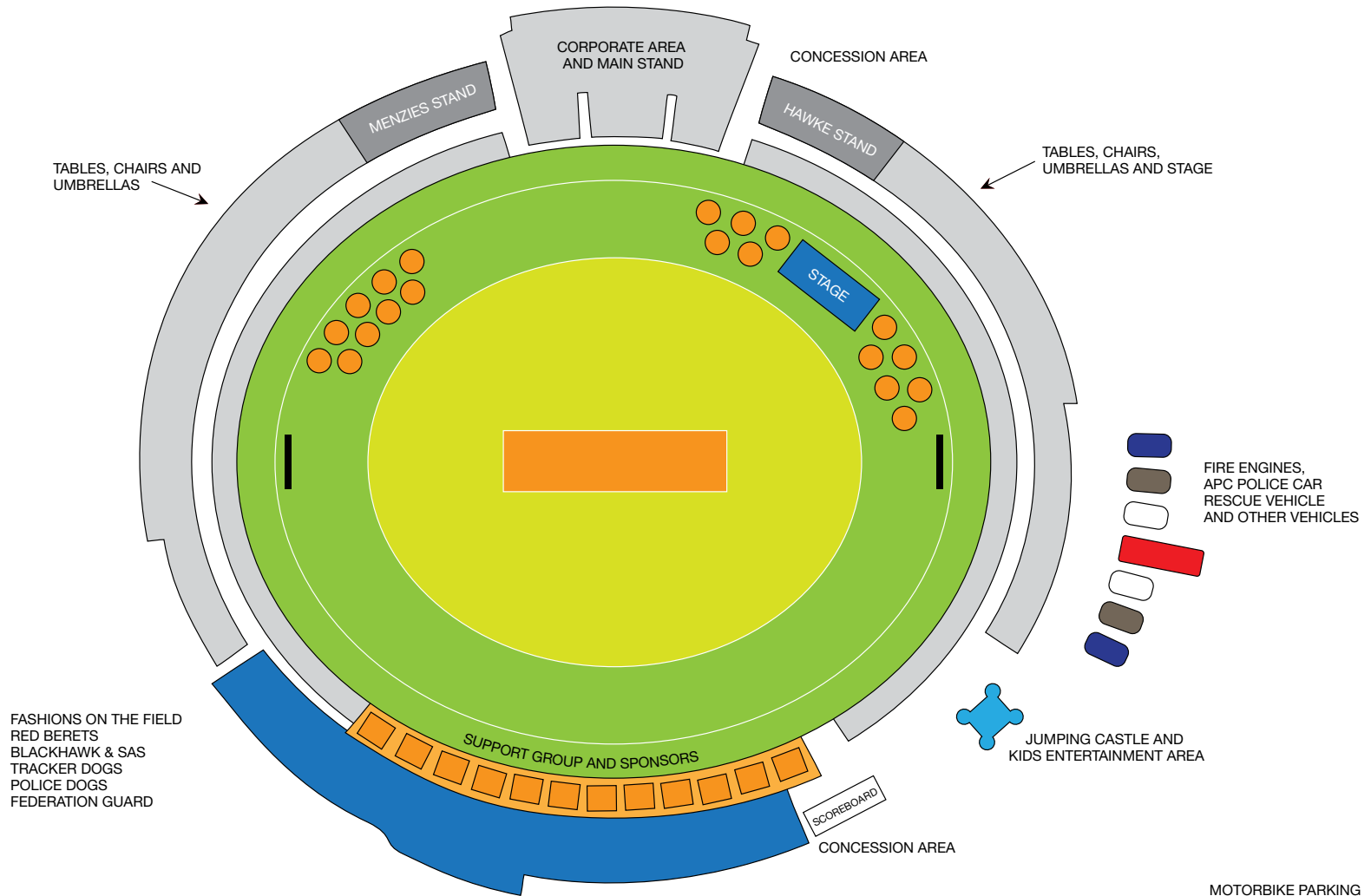
